

### Project Details:

Over the next 10 to 15 years the Government is investing in every secondary school across England. The scheme aims to renew or rebuild every secondary school in the country, this is known as Building Schools for the Future (BSF).

South Tyneside and Gateshead Councils have passed the final milestone in their plans to build new secondary schools in South Tyneside and Gateshead under the Building Schools for the Future (BSF) programme by the signing of contracts and reaching financial close with inspiredspaces.

Financial Close was reached on the multi million pound programme that will transform a large number of secondary schools across South Tyneside and Gateshead (STaG) in the Building Schools for the Future (BSF) programme confirming that the legal contracts have been completed and signed. This followed months of negotiations after the company was unveiled as the Councils' preferred bidder.

Inspiredspaces are formed by support services and construction company Carillion and its joint venture partners, The Local Education Partnership (LEP). The organisation includes c2a Limited (education), Ryder Architects, Colour UDL (landscape architects), Carillion Building, Cundalls (engineers), Morse (ICT), Fsquared (funding and regeneration) and many others.

The £140 million scheme consists of twelve schools across two Local Education Authorities (LEA), including two schools in Gateshead and ten schools across South tyneside.

The scheme included one privately funded new build secondary school, three redeveloped schools in South Tyneside and two new schools built in Gateshead

The redevelopment of Jarrow School and Mortimer Community College were the first schools to be developed under the first wave of the BSF Scheme.

### Extranet Details:

South Tyneside and Gateshead Council selected 4Projects® to streamline the bid management throughout the tendering process. Seven consortia utilised the secure solution to access all tender information and then submit their bids online before the tender deadline expired.
